## **i4i Invention for Innovation programme is launching its third call**

The i4i Invention for Innovation programme is launching its third call for early and late-stage product development awards on 1 November. The competition is open from 1 November to 7 December (5pm).

i4i is positioned to transform the translation of healthcare technologies for increased patient benefit through:

- Guided progression of innovative medical product prototypes, and
- Provision of business advice to the medical technology professionals it funds.

There is a single route of entry into the i4i programme. Invited full applications will be assigned to one of two Selection Panels (Early-stage and Late-stage) for assessment.

The NIHR RDS NW advice service is able to offer research design advice when developing a proposal for the i4i programme.

#### **NIHR HTA commissioned call – outline deadline Closing date: 09 February 2012**

The HTA programme supports research that is immediately useful to clinical practice and policy/decision makers. HTA research is undertaken when there is evidence to show the technology is efficacious but there is uncertainty around its clinical and cost effectiveness in a real life NHS setting in comparison to the current best alternative(s). There may also be uncertainty around its place in the existing care pathway.
