My primary research interest is in the development of an acceptable and feasible psychological intervention for people with personality disorder trait that presents primary care IAPT Services, IAPT being Improving Access to Psychological Therapy Services.

This advice has led to me developing a research advisory steering group which is made of patients which certainly enhance my research in practice.

I also found the Research Design Service able to offer me very useful external, critical appraisal advice when I was developing the application and were able to offer me step by step guidance that helped me with my research design including the development of a research flow chart that I was able to add to my application.

One of the things I was surprised about was the fact that this wasn't just a one off contact. I got frequent support during my application process and really found the consistency of the case management process of great benefit.
