

Privacy Statement for NIHR Research Design Service North West

The purpose of this privacy document is to set out what data we collect, why we collect it and how long we will keep it for. Please consult our <u>confidentiality statement</u> for information on how we handle the content of your project applications and associated intellectual property.

The National Institute for Health Research (NIHR) Research Design Service North West (RDS NW) complies fully with the General Data Protection Regulations.

Project development support

As a recipient of support from the RDS NW, we will collect and securely store project information relating to your application to facilitate our advice giving. We will retain that data until one year after the end of our successive RDS NW contracts.

We additionally categorise our support by category and time spent. This information will be shared annually, along with details pertaining to the project's principal investigator, with the NIHR Central Commissioning Facility (CCF) to evaluate the management and delivery of the Research Design Service (RDS). The CCF is part of the Department for Health and Social Care (DHSC) NIHR. All information will be held securely and treated in the strictest confidence by the RDS, CCF and NIHR.

The <u>NIHR privacy policy</u> includes further information including ways NIHR may use your data, contact details and details of your individual rights in relation to how your data will be used. This includes details of the information collected by NIHR, why it is collected, how long it will be retained and how the information will be used.

Evaluations

From time to time the RDS NW will ask you, anonymously, to evaluate the service that you have received, whether it is project support or, for example, event attendance. The feedback we receive is used to improve our service and quotes may be used as feedback to our funders. Collated data will be kept until one year after the end of successive RDS NW contracts, individual data will be kept for one year.

CCF asks us to circulate their RDS evaluation survey each year, to those who we have provided application support to in the latest annual reporting period. Please consult the <u>NIHR privacy policy</u> for the handling of that data.

Mailing list subscriptions

If you've signed up to an RDS NW news alert, newsletter, bulletin or other similar publication then your name and email may be stored securely in a database hosted at Lancaster University and you can unsubscribe at any time by sending an email to rds-nw@lancaster.ac.uk. RDS NW will not share your details with a third party. Your data will be kept until one year after the end of successive RDS NW contracts or until you unsubscribe.

Event bookings

By signing up to attend a national RDS or RDS NW event you consent to the collection and storage of your booking data. This data will be used to facilitate the administration of the event and the evaluation of our effectiveness to reach and engage with researchers throughout our region and nationally. Collated data

will be kept until one year after the end of successive RDS contracts, individual data will be kept for one year unless it relates to photo permissions in which case it will be held until the end of the RDS contract plus one year.

RDS NW use Eventbrite to manage their bookings. Information on how Eventbrite manage booking data can be found here: <u>privacy policy</u>

Website analytics

RDS NW collect data, via <u>Google Analytics</u>, on how our website is used, for example page views. This information is used to improve our website, tailor our information to user needs and monitor interest in certain areas such as our RDS NW videos. While your IP address is passed to Google, no data specific to any identifiable user is retained. Data retention

Your contact information will be removed from our records, one year after the end of successive RDS NW contracts, unless the information relates to a financial transaction when we are obliged to retain it for up to seven years for auditing purposes.
