# NIHR rapid funding call on Mental Health Research in Northern England launching 1 June 2021

An NIHR rapid funding call is launching 1 June 2021 targeting research in populations in the North West, Yorkshire and Humber and the North East and North Cumbria.

The call is for research to better understand and manage the health and social care consequences of mental health conditions. Applications can be for either the NIHR Research for Patient Benefit (RfPB) or NIHR Research for Social Care (RfSC) funding calls. This is a rapid call with a one-stage application with a **deadline 22 June 2021**, and an expression of interest stage with a **deadline 15 June 2021**.

## RDS Blog: Platform trials: full steam ahead?

Clinical trials provide the highest quality evidence on the benefits and harms of new healthcare interventions. Nevertheless, the cost of conducting clinical trials is high, and increasing.

New approaches for designing, conducting and analysing clinical trials are playing an important role in improving their efficiency, which means reducing the cost and time taken without compromising level of evidence provided. One way to do this is through combining (what used to be) several clinical trials testing related questions into a single platform trial.
