# Mental Health Research in Northern England - Round 2

The <u>NIHR Research for Patient Benefit</u> (RfPB) and <u>Research for Social Care</u> (RfSC) programmes <u>are inviting proposals from research teams</u> to better understand and manage the health and social care consequences of mental health conditions.

The programmes are particularly interested in populations in Northern England where there is a high mental health burden and which have been historically underserved by research activity.

Calls for both programmes will launch in July 2021, with submission deadlines in November 2021 for RfPB and in October 2021 for RfSC.
