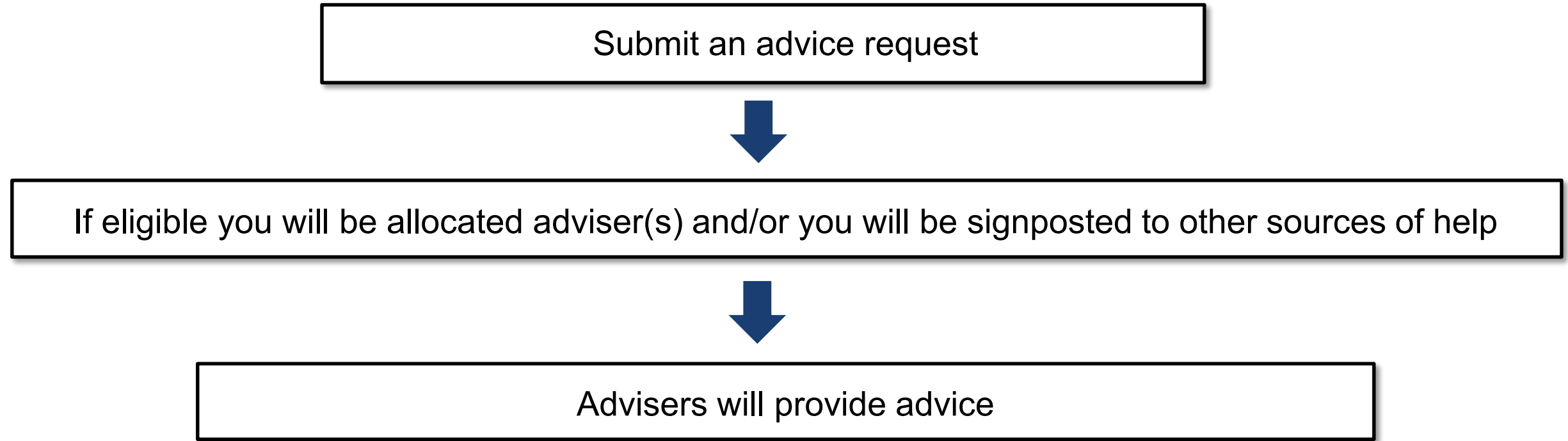

Depending on your needs we may cover:

- existing research / literature review
- potential funding streams
- study design
- feasibility of recruitment strategy
- track record of team
- Public Involvement.



The RDS

- Researchers who use the RDS are highly satisfied with the service and say their needs are fully met or exceeded.*
- Research teams who use the RDS believe their applications improve considerably following RDS support.*
- Researchers who use the RDS say they would recommend the service to others.*

*An independent survey found that RDS users were satisfied with RDS support and that their expectations had been either 'fully met' (56%) or 'exceeded' (23%). 87% reported a high level of improvement in their research applications, with similar ratings for those who self-categorised as "just starting", "developing", or "experienced" in research or as having "substantial experience". More than 90% were likely to recommend the RDS to their colleagues.

The RDS

Research teams supported by the RDS are awarded more than **£240 million** each year to deliver their research.*

*Data collected across the ten RDS regions in 2021 showed that the Service supports over 3100 research teams each year and that the average yearly value of successful applications is more than £243 million.
